Launched as a three-month training course, Grow MORE Together introduces clients to every stage of garden management, from preparing soil and planting seeds to harvesting and maintenance. But the impact doesn't end there—graduates of the course will take the lead in maintaining the garden throughout the year, putting their new skills to use in a meaningful and empowering way.

The program is made even stronger through our partnership with UCCE CalFresh Healthy Living and the UC Master Gardeners of El Dorado County, who bring expert guidance, education, and support to each step of the process.

Looking ahead, participants dream of running a garden stand where they can sell produce, flower bouquets, and seedlings gaining valuable vocational and entrepreneurial experience.

A key piece of this vision is the greenhouse donated during our 2020 remodel. Plans are underway to enhance and equip the space to support the year-round training and production needs of Grow MORE Together—transforming it into the heart of the program and a hub of learning, growth, and possibility. We dream big at MORE ... the possibility of employment in the agriculture community for clients of MORE could just be the beginning!
